AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE VILLAGE OF BISMARCK

WHEREAS the Village owns a CD-ROM component and a digital answering machine that are no longer necessary or useful to the Village.

WHEREAS said personal property is of small value and it is not necessary to take bids on its sale.

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the Village to sell said personal property at the best price obtainable at the discretion of the Mayor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bismarck, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the CD-ROM component and digital answering machine be sold for the best price obtainable without the necessity of taking bids at the discretion of the Mayor.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
