Code Enforcement Officer Charles Stahl was in attendance. Committee member Zach Hagley was absent. A quorum was established. - 5. Chairman Comments/Public Comments/Questions

Chairman Kentner welcomed everyone to the meeting. He stated he was glad to see a packed house. Residents addressed the planning commission about a possible Solar Farm coming into Bismarck on 2650. Chairman Kentner stated that as far as he knows the Planning Commission and the Village Board of Trustees has not been approached about any such matters. The Village Attorney stated there is a process if a company is interested in purchasing the land for such usage. It was asked if the Village has any sort of ordinance for solar farms and wind farms. At this time the Village does not and so the law that would have to be followed would fall down to what the statute and ordinances for the county and state are. It was asked if the Village Board and Planning Commission should be proactive in getting something in place. Residents are concerned about the possibility of a solar farm, and many do not want one placed on the property on 2650. It was discussed that the process would require a public hearing because the current zoning of the property is agricultural. It appears that to have a solar farm the zoning would need to be changed. The residents asked if there was anything they could do. It was discussed they could possibly do a petition and present to the Village Board of Trustees so they would know where the residents stood if something would transpire. There are guidelines and time restraints for such matters. Property owners have rights and things would have to be addressed appropriately. At this time the planning commission has no information about a company or a request to place a solar farm on 2650.
